Proper Battery Disposal

Properly dispose of batteries by placing them in a clear zipper bag on top of the black garbage cart on your regular pick-up day or by bringing them to a collection site. Bulky Item Collection

Single-family residents may call Recology to schedule up to two (2) no-cost curbside Bulky Item Collections per year[^] for large items that don't fit into carts. Additional pickups may be requested for a fee. Multi-family complexes can coordinate large item collection events through their property managers.
