



Items NOT ACCEPTED in 3YD / 4YD / 6YD Temporary COD Bins

Applies to All COD Bins

** NO HEAVY ITEMS

- NO Construction Materials
- NO Remodeling Materials
- NO Carpet or Padding
- NO Mattresses
- NO Furniture
- NO Large Appliances
- NO Computers or Monitors
- NO Televisions
- NO Fluorescent Tubes
- NO Microwaves
- NO Concrete
- NO Rocks or Gravel
- NO Stumps/Trunks or Branches larger than 2" in diameter

NO DIRT OR SOD OF ANY KIND (THIS IS VERY IMPORTANT)

- NO Large Metal Items
- NO Car Parts
- NO Tires
- NO Toxic Waste or Chemicals (including Industrial Waste)
- NO Treated Wood – (Pressure Treated – green fence posts- Creosote, etc)

Note: Wood is ok in Bins – Painted wood is ok

Upon **REMOVAL** of Bins - lids must be **Completely Closed**- Bin must be in same place as it was for delivery

The bin should not be heavier than 500 pounds. Rule of thumb: if the bin CANNOT be moved by 1 person, likely it weighs more than 500 pounds.
