	Cover your bins! Secure garbage and recycling bins from birds, animals, wind, etc.

	Pick it up. See garbage on the street or sidewalk? Put it in the closest garbage can. Model behavior that others will emulate.
	Pick up after your pet! Pet waste left on the ground can contaminate soil and local waterways. Bagged waste goes in the trash.
	Trash those butts! Cigarette butts are the most littered item in San Mateo and are dangerous to wildlife. Safely ensure they go in the trash bin.
