How do I know if I qualify?

The program applies to residential single-family Recology customers in San Carlos. Qualification is based on gross annual household income. Residents who receive the PG&E CARE discount on their monthly PG&E bills automatically qualify for the 10% Solid Waste Rate Reduction Program. If you think you qualify for the PG&E CARE Program but have not yet signed up, visit the PG&E CARE website, email careprogram@pge.com or call (866) 743-2273. You must be enrolled in PG&E's Care Program to receive the City's 10% Solid Waste Discount.

CURBSIDE BATTERY COLLECTION PROGRAM

Follow the steps below to correctly handle your used household batteries. More information at **RethinkBatteries.org.**



STEP 1: COLLECT IT! Collect all your household batteries.



STEP 2: TAPE IT! Prevent battery fires by using clear tape over lithium-ion and 9-volt battery terminals.



STEP 3: BAG IT! Put all your batteries into <u>a clear, sealed</u> <u>zip-top bag</u> to prevent spills.



STEP 4: PLACE IT! Place the sealed bag on top of your black garbage cart on your regular collection day.
