Recycle Cart



PLASTICS

- All plastics (with or without symbols)
- Bubble wrap
- Clean and dry plastic bags and film plastic (bagged)



GLASS AND METAL

- Empty aerosol cans
- Aluminum, steel, and bi-metal cans
- Aluminum foil (no food)
- Glass bottles and jars



MIXED PAPER

- Books, paperback and hardcover
- Cereal and cracker boxes (plastic liners removed)
- Envelopes, junk mail, paper bags
- Shredded paper (in a paper bag stapled or taped closed)



CARDBOARD

- Flattened cardboard
- Oversized cardboard must be flattened no larger than 3ft x 3ft sections and bundled or neatly stacked next to the recycling cart



⊘ No packaging and polystyrene foam

When sorting recyclable materials, there are three simple rules:

EMPTY, CLEAN AND DRY!



Empty any residual food or liquid from a bottle or container, clean the product by quickly rinsing or scraping off debris, and shake the container to remove moisture before tossing in your recycling bin.

Organics Cart



FOOD SCRAPS

- Fruits and vegetables
- Meat, poultry and seafood
- Rice, beans and pasta
- Eggshells
- Dairy products (no liquids)
- Coffee grounds and filters



YARD TRIMMINGS

- Branches and brush
- Flowers and floral trimmings
- Grasses and weeds
- Leaves and tree trimmings



SOILED PAPER PRODUCTS

- Paper bags, napkins, towels, cups and plates
- Coffee filters
- Uncoated paper take-out containers
- Waxed cardboard and paper, and milk cartons
- Greasy pizza boxes
- Paper ice cream containers
- Paper take-out boxes and containers
- Paper tea bags



Line your container with newspaper, paper bags, or BPI certified compostable bags.

Garbage Cart



- Chip bags, candy and granola bar wrappers
- Cat litter and pet waste
- Diapers and feminine products
- Disposable masks and gloves
- Packaging and polystyrene foam, meat trays and other packing material
- Compostable plastics and cornstarch items
- Aseptic containers
- Garden hoses, rubber gloves and extension cords
- Dirty plastic, metal or plastic packaging
- Straws and plastic utensils
- Ashes
- Textiles, leather, hangers
- Diseased and bug infested material

Holiday Tree Recycling

Before setting your tree on your curb for pickup:

1. Make sure your organics cart is at the curb alongside your tree.
2. Cut trees not to exceed five feet in length. Small pieces can go inside the cart.
3. Remove decorations, tinsel and tree stands.
4. Flocked trees accepted.
5. Please ensure lid is closed.



What is SB1383?

Senate Bill 1383 (SB1383) is a law enacted by the State of California that builds upon the state's leading commitments to reduce greenhouse gas emissions and air pollution statewide.

SB1383 requires all businesses and residents to divert organic materials (including: food waste, yard waste and soiled paper products) from the landfill. Starting January 1st, 2022 regulations take effect.

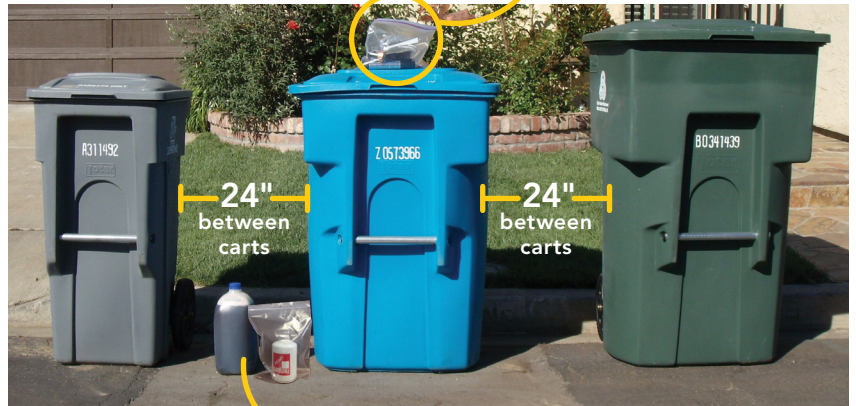
This law also requires the state to increase edible food recovery by 20% by 2025.

Service Reminders

- Set our materials by 6 am on your scheduled collection day.
A special charge may be incurred if collection trucks need to return for late set-outs or over-packed carts.
- Prior arrangements must be made with Recology for extra garbage pickup.
- To purchase extra garbage stickers, contact Recology.
- Attach one extra garbage sticker to each securely closed 32-gallon bag and place next to your cart.

Never place batteries inside the carts.

Place household batteries in clear bags on top of recyclables cart, tape battery ends before bagging

Bulky Items

Accepted items include appliances, water heaters, furniture, BBQs, and lawn mowers.



On-Call Collection

1. Normal household debris only.
2. No one item or container to exceed 70lbs or longer than 6ft.
3. All items must be manageable by one person and fit within a 6ft long, 6ft wide, 6ft high area.
4. All items must be bagged, boxed, or bundled and placed curbside by 6 am.



UNACCEPTABLE

Dirt, rock, concrete, paint, Freon-containing appliances, and other hazardous materials.
