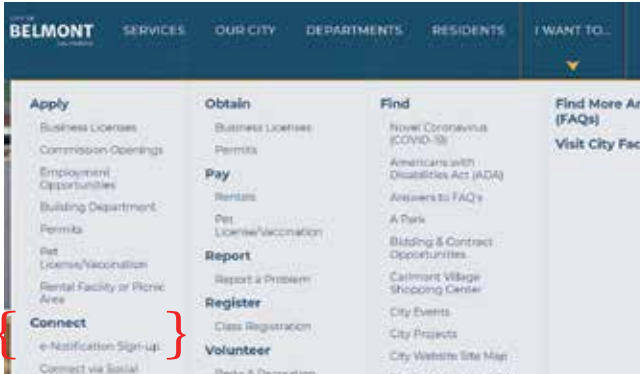

Nearly 800 residents have participated in **Your Voice, Your Belmont**, shaping the City's priorities into the next budget year. Now more than ever, it is important to hear community feedback on City service needs and priorities.

As we continue to witness firsthand the importance of local control for local needs in our community, the City continues to work towards being self-sufficient in the event of any emergency.

Through **Your Voice, Your Belmont**, the following community priorities have been identified:

- ✓ Fixing potholes, and repairing streets and sidewalks
- ✓ Maintaining 9-1-1 emergency response times
- ✓ Maintaining parks, open space and sports fields
- ✓ Maintaining neighborhood police patrols and crime prevention

- ✓ Maintaining Public Works staff necessary to keep streets, like Ralston Avenue improvements, and sewer projects on-time and on-budget and
- ✓ Keeping public areas healthy, safe and clean
