



COMPOSTING IS NOW THE LAW—SB 1383

Please remember to place yard waste, food scraps and food-soiled paper towels and napkins in your green organics cart. Composting this material instead of sending it to the landfill helps reduce greenhouse gas emissions and is used to create nutrient-rich compost.

When collecting food scraps do not use plastic bags, including “compostable” or “biodegradable” bags. Consider using a kitchen pail or paper bag.

WHY COMPOSTING MATTERS

CalRecycle estimates that more than 40% of the waste disposed in landfills could have been composted instead.

Keeping food and other compostable materials out of landfills is one of the easiest actions you can take to reduce your carbon footprint.

In Vallejo Unincorporated, residents can place food scraps, food soiled uncoated paper, and yard trimmings in their green bins for collection. Once collected, these items are transported to our compost facility where we grind the material and place it in piles known as windrows. We add heat and water to the piles and end up with a nutrient-rich soil amendment used by farmers and landscapers.

Residential customers may schedule one collection each year at no additional charge.

Residents are entitled to 12, 32-gallon garbage bags, weighing no more than 60 pounds or up to two items. Items must be placed out by 5 AM on collection day.

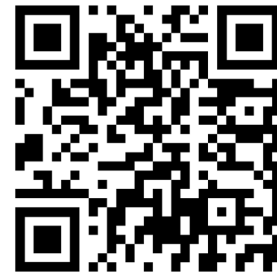

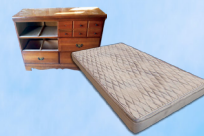
