Property Managers need to schedule tree collections with Recology on behalf of the entire complex. Holiday trees can be collected in centrally located areas, on-site compost bins, or in a debris box for no additional charge between January 2nd and January 31st. For proper TreeCycling, please inform residents to remove all decorations, lights and tree stands (flocked trees are accepted).



New California Law Requires Multi-Family Dwellings to Compost

Senate Bill (SB) 1383 is a law enacted by the State of California to reduce emissions of short-lived climate pollutants like methane. The law seeks to achieve a 75% reduction in the statewide disposal of organic waste.

HOW DOES THIS AFFECT MY PROPERTY?

Due to State Law, all generators are now required to place food scraps, food and beverage soiled paper products, and yard trimmings in the green compost container or self-haul all compostable material to a composting facility or program.
