November 8, 2022 is Election Day

This November, Belmont voters in Districts 1 and 3 will elect Councilmembers and all Belmont voters will elect an At-Large Mayor.

To comply with the California Voting Rights Act of 2001 (CVRA), passed in 2002 and prohibits at-large elections; on Nov. 9, 2021 Belmont City Council adopted a resolution outlining Belmont's intention to transition from at-large to district-based elections with a directly elected mayor.

From January until March 2022, Council and staff conducted a series of outreach, community meetings and public hearings to determine Belmont's new voting districts.

This year, the call for nominations in Districts 1 & 3, and At-large Mayor concluded on Aug. 12 and candidates were announced on Aug. 19.
