As we continue to witness firsthand the importance of local control for local needs in our community, the City continues to work towards being self-sufficient in the event of any emergency.

Through **Your Voice, Your Belmont**, the following community priorities have been identified (see survey results to-date at [www.Belmont.gov/Conversation](http://www.Belmont.gov/Conversation)).

- ✓ Fixing potholes, and repairing streets and sidewalks
- ✓ Maintaining 9-1-1 emergency response times
- ✓ Maintaining parks, open space and sports fields

- ✓ Maintaining Public Works staff necessary to keep streets, like Ralston Avenue improvements, and sewer projects on-time and on-budget and
- ✓ Keeping public areas healthy, safe and clean
