FROM THE BELMONT CITY MANAGER'S OFFICE

Dear Belmont Resident,

As we begin preparations for this year's budget process, we are adamant in ensuring the entire Belmont community has the opportunity to participate and be heard. As you may have seen, over the past year, the City has relaunched Your Voice, Your Belmont to hear feedback from our community on local City service needs and priorities.

What recent crisis has taught us is that now more than ever, Belmont must have the local control and capacity to be self-sufficient to support our local community in the event of any emergency. The City must have local control over local funds for local needs, allowing Belmont to be self-reliant and ensuring that our tax dollars are spent here in Belmont and not taken by Sacramento.

During this year's budget process, we want to make sure to reflect the City services the community relies on the most. Belmont residents have recently identified the following priorities:

- Fixing potholes and repairing streets and sidewalks
- Maintaining 9-1-1 emergency response times
- Maintaining parks, open space and sports fields
- Maintaining neighborhood police patrols and crime prevention
- Maintaining Public Works staff necessary to keep streets, like the Ralston Avenue improvements, and sewer projects on-time and on-budget
- Keeping public areas healthy, safe and clean
