In the first four months of 2023, Belmont city staff and its emergency partners **responded to over 750** calls for service. One day alone, **25 trees fell** and our Police, Parks & Recreation, Public Works and partner teams acted quickly to remove safety hazards in our community, just like they always do when called to action.



Although these storms caught many by surprise, they are predicted by scientists to happen more frequently as weather patterns continue to change.

As we have learned early this year, we **must be prepared** for future storms to reduce flooding and maintain our storm drain infrastructure.

During the storms, we created and promoted a [webpage resource](#) for our residents so they can make storm preparation and response a priority.

We are all **in this together**, especially when our city, emergency, and partner agency staff are stretched thin.

Our city team proved its mettle in the worst of scenarios and we hope the online resource remains a trusted source for residents to make their own preparations and storm response plans.
