**LANDFILL** - Single-use plastics, diapers and pet waste, hoses, and treated wood.

### Waste Compliance Services

SB 1383 mandates all customers separate recyclables and organic waste. Recology will assist you in complying with this new state mandate. To ensure compliance, we are required to monitor contamination.

### Debris Box Service

Recology offers 20, 30, and 40-yard debris box rentals; and 10-yard dirt and concrete boxes are also available. Please contact us to schedule.

### Enclosure and Container Lock Services
